WELCOME TO SALLA, LAPLAND – A DIFFERENT KIND OF ORIENTEERING WEEK IN THE MIDDLE OF NOWHERE

FIN5 SALLA is a five-day orienteering event where everyone, regardless of age and orienteering skills, can get to know orienteering and experience the wilderness of Salla from a new perspective.

The FIN5 orienteering event has been organized in Finland since the 1980s, but only once before has the event been held in Lapland. The competition centre will remain in the same location for the whole week, in the Salla Wilderness Park, which also serves as the Visitor Centre of Salla National Park.

The FIN5 orienteering event will bring together experienced competitive orienteers, fitness orienteers and first-time orienteers in different terrains every day. Two days will be spent orienteering in the national park, the sprint will be run in a reindeer fence and the last day will be spent also in a protected forest area. Many thanks to Finnish Parks and Wildlife for allowing us to organize the race in such a great setting.

The competition centre is accessible by public transport! There is a night train from Helsinki to Kemijärvi (vr.fi) and a bus connection from the train to Salla-Sallatunturi, final stop is at the competition centre. There is also a bus connection from Kuusamo flights to Sallatunturi. Those staying at Sallatunturi area do not need parking, as you can leave your car in the yard of your accommodation and go to the competition centre either by bus, bike or walking. For day visitors there is a parking area available by extra fee at Sallatunturi.

In addition to new orienteering terrain and experiences, the week will feature a wide range of activities. Come and experience the atmosphere of the International Orienteering Event in the middle of nowhere!

 - o Muksula: Supervised childcare for pre-schoolers (advance registration required <u>sallashop.visitsalla.fi</u>)

































COMPETITION DAYS



July 5 (Day 1) - Long Distance, Salla National Park

Terrain: Mostly pine forest with good visibility; some rocky and mossy spruce areas.



July 6 (Day 2) - Middle Distance, Salla National Park

Terrain: Eastern Lapland style—swamps, spruce forests, and pine ridges. Some detailed and stony areas. Trails intentionally avoided in course planning.



July 7 (Day 3) - Middle Distance

Terrain: Features a winding Hangasoja stream; otherwise, easy to run.































COMPETITION DAYS



July 9 (Day 4) - Forest Sprint

Terrain: Inside an authentic reindeer enclosure. Expect reindeer and confusing tracks.



July 10 (Day 5) - Middle Distance, Protected Area

Pirttivaara: Steep hills, only one path. Observation points at the top—if you have time to stop!

































RULES & MAPS

- IOF and Finnish Orienteering Federation rules apply.
- Maps: Mapped by Sallan Karhut / Tatu Hänninen and Routamap Oy / Anssi Koirikivi
- Scales: For competition days 1, 2, 3, and 5: Map scale is 1:7500 for HD50 and older, as well as for RR and TR classes, and Open AL, BL, and C classes.
 All other classes use a 1:10 000 scale.
 On day 4, the map scale is 1:4000 for all classes.
- All competition areas are under embargo (training forbidden). The embargoed areas are listed in the Finnish Orienteering Federation's map register karttarekisteri.fi.



EMIT SYSTEM

- EMIT required for all classes. The Emit card number must be provided at the time of registration.
- EMIT rental: €25/week or €5/day (advance); €30/week or €7/day (onsite).
- Unreturned EMIT card: €90 charge.
- Change of The EMIT number is free of charge until June 10 in IRMA (after that €10 office fee will be charged)

TRANSPORT & PARKING

- No parking at the competition center.
- Parking at Salla Sports Center with shuttle service (~3 km).

STARTS & TRAINING

- Starts: 1.0–2.5 km from center.
- Kids' starts nearby.

PRIZES

- The results in the competition classes are determined based on the total time. In the open classes, total times are not calculated.
- The top three overall competitors in the classes will be awarded as follows
 - o H/D 21E: 1st €3,000 / 2nd €2,000 / 3rd €1,000
 - o H/D16-20E: 1st €300 / 2nd €250 / 3rd €200
- In other competition classes: Top 1-3 competitors will be awarded local product prizes
- Kids and family classes receive participation prizes.
